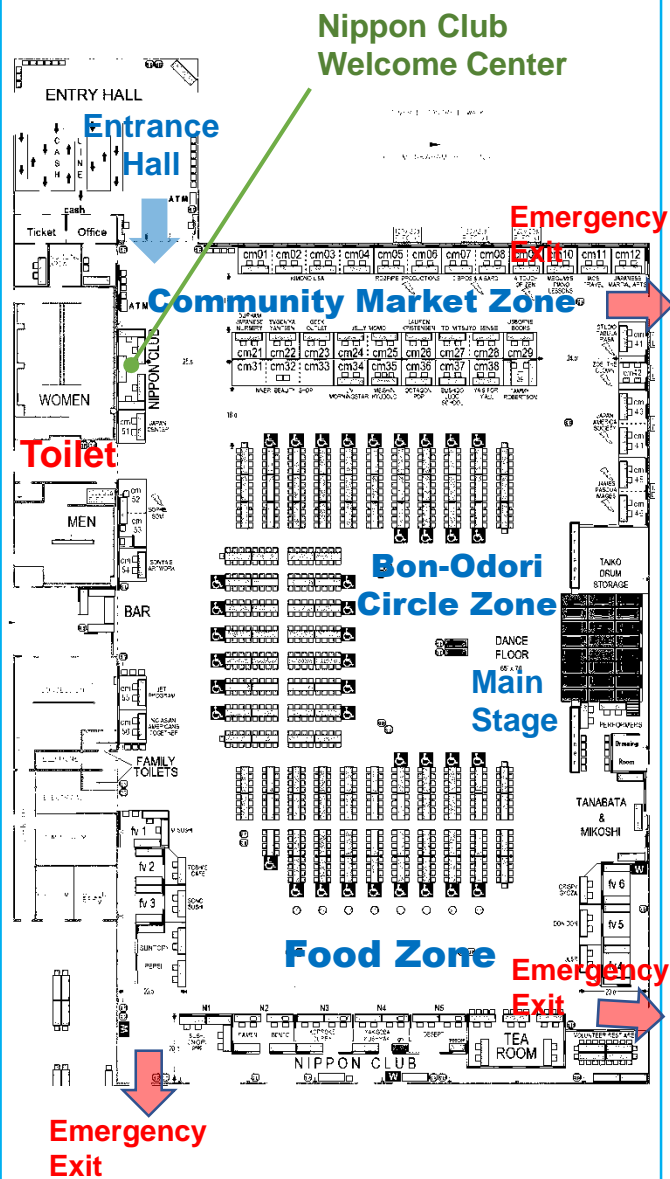

1. Bon Festival
It is a Buddhist memorial event in honor of one's ancestors. Bon-Odori is the local folk dance performed in a circle during the festival. For many Japanese, it would not be summer without a Bon-Odori
2. Tanabata Festival
It is the Star Festival based on a Chinese legend and celebrated on July 7 or August 7 every year. People write wishes on strips of fancy paper and display on bamboo tree.
